

Coronation of King Charles III Discretionary Charging Policy



PPL and PRS for Music have chosen not to charge a licence royalty for music played or performed at certain small community events, such as street parties, celebrating the 2023 Coronation of King Charles III where ALL of the following criteria are met.

The event must:



1. Be in celebration of The Coronation



2. Take place between 5th and 8th May
2023



3. Be held in a premises or a place that does not otherwise require, or currently hold,
TheMusicLicence



4. Be provided for the local community



5. Have a total expected attendance /
capacity 300 or fewer



6. Not generate a profit



7. Be organised and run by unpaid
volunteers

What does this mean for my event?

My event meet ALL of the above criteria

If your event meets ALL of the above criteria, the discretionary charging policy is likely to apply, but you will still need to apply for a licence via the [Charity & Community Discount Form](#).

My event or organisation doesn't meet ALL of the above criteria

If any of the above conditions are not met, the discretionary charging policy will not apply and instead the relevant PPL tariffs and PRS for Music tariffs will be applied in the usual way. Visit the [Get TheMusicLicence](#) page to arrange a licence for the music at your event.
