Background Music Tariff - Telephone Music On Hold

THIS TARIFF IS EFFECTIVE FROM 01-JAN-21 TO 31-DEC-21

NOTES:

For the public performance of sound recordings solely as background music via a telephone music on hold system. The licence does not permit the re-recording/editing/dubbing/copying/transfer of copyright material. If the telephone music on hold system uses a digital memory facility (which requires a copy of the sound recording to be made), the licensee will require the services of a PPL dubbing licensee.

Where an Internet Protocol (IP) based telephone system (which uses an IP network such as the internet to transmit calls), or other equivalent system, is in use the total call capacity of the system should be used to calculate the fees due.. "Call capacity" means the potential number of callers to whom music on hold can be played at any one time with each unit of call capacity equal to one external line.

Additional use of background music in other areas of the premises where telephone music on hold is supplied (bars, canteens, waiting room etc) to be charged separately using the appropriate tariffs.
